It began when a small group of Expats started having Sunday meetings for their fellow Expats in March 2001 with the primary goal of being a place where Expats could share information among themselves about living in Pattaya – where to get services, where to find certain products, etc.

Since the start and as the Club grew, it became much more than just a venue to exchange information. Speakers were invited to the meetings to talk on subjects of interest to Expats. The Club also offers a book exchange table at the Sunday meetings.

The Club helps facilitate various member organized activities such as special interest groups and excursions that take place outside of the regular meetings offering the opportunity to socialize and make friends with others that share a common interest.

Additionally, some Club members have volunteered to assist others in getting a Thai driving license and answering specific questions about Thai Immigration matters – these services are available to members and non-members.

The Club also has this website to provide a wealth of information of interest to both Expats and visitors and provides a weekly Newsletter about the Club's activities and upcoming events of interest to Expats and visitors alike.

The Club does not restrict most of its activities to members only; guests are welcome to join in. However, there are certain benefits available only to members of the Club. The Club is a social organization; it has no commercial activities to generate funds on which to operate. So, one of the primary benefit of joining is that your dues allow the Club's activities to continue in providing a venue for Expats to meet, interact, and exchange information – not to mention meeting and making new friends. The other member benefits include discounts at several restaurants, businesses, and two International hospitals; these discounts over a year can far exceed the amount of the annual membership dues, which is only 400 Baht.

DRIVING LICENSE & IMMIGRATION ASSISTANCE

[THAI IMMIGRATION ASSISTANCE](#)

The Thai Immigration Office for Expats or visitors residing or staying in Pattaya is the Chonburi Immigration Office. It is located on Jomtien Beach Soi 5. While it would be difficult to find a true “expert” on Thai Immigration issues, Club Member Darrel Vaught manages to stay up to date on most matters related to this Immigration Office. He will provide advice or answer questions at the regular Sunday meeting – just ask anyone and they will point him out to you. As most Expats soon learn, each Immigration Office (or even Immigration Officers within an Office) may interpret the rules differently.

Also, it is not unknown for Immigration to announce new rules or procedures without much, if any, advance notice. The Website information is updated based on the latest reports from Expats and visitors on their experience with the Chonburi Immigration Office. THE CLUB'S ACTIVITIES

Whether you are taking up residence in Thailand or just visiting, one of the most common concerns is making new friends. Although from varied backgrounds and differing nationalities, the Club helps Expats meet others and form friendships through many activities associated with the Club, such as Special Interest Groups and Excursions. These activities are organized by individual members or others; not the Pattaya City Expat Club. But, the Club endeavors to facilitate these activities by encouraging members and others to organize them and by letting others know about their activities through the Club's Newsletter, Website, and Meeting announcements.

Special Interest Groups ¹ – There are usually about a dozen groups that meet outside of regular meetings to share a common interest. Some meet weekly, some monthly, and others periodically. Wining and Dining Together - The Club has a monthly Dinner get together where members and guests can enjoy a good meal in a nice social setting. These dinners take place at a different restaurant each month. The Club also has several members that enjoy the many Wine Dinners put on by several of Pattaya's finer dining establishments – these members often arrange for a PCEC table at these Wine Dinners. Contributing to the Thai Community - Club members also try to help the Thai community. The English conversation for Thais group is officially sanctioned by the Banglamung District government and provides English conversation classes for government and business employees, students, and Thai navy personnel – volunteers from the Club participate in these classes which are offered free of charge to the Thai participants. After hearing a guest speaker talk about his Non-Government Organization's effort to eradicate poverty in rural Thai villages, several members formed another group to join with the NGO by partnering with a specific village so they could participate in the program. BENEFITS OF MEMBERSHIP



Club members receive discounts at restaurants, businesses, and two International Hospitals. The discounts vary – generally from 10 to 20 percent – when you show your Pattaya City Expats Club membership card. Also, the Club has a Group Hospital Insurance Policy.

Group Health Insurance Policy

The policy will accept applicants under 70 and will continue coverage to age 75. Under the Group policy, you can renew up to age 75. Once you are 76, you may renew, but this is on a case by case basis and determined by insurer. If you are interested in taking advantage of the group policy, see Kuhn Neng, broker who is usually present from 11am till noon at the Club's Sunday meeting. Discounts at Two International Hospitals

Two International Hospitals offer some discounts to Club Members. Both Hospitals offer a wide variety of medical services.

Bangkok Pattaya Hospital – Many club members use this Hospital located on Sukhumvit Road just north of Pattaya Nua (North Road). Show Club membership card to the Cashier to receive the discount. As a Club member you and your family members will get a 10% discount on Pharmaceutical items (excludes all types of vaccination/special medicines), a 10% discount on in-patient room rate (excludes ICU, CCU and NICU), and a 10% discount on dental fees for general dentistry (extraction, filling, dental scaling) and a 5% for prosthodontic treatment. The discount is for self pay only and cannot be used with personal health insurance or other (promotional campaign, special discount etc.) [Click here](#) for their website.



Phyathai Sriracha General Hospital – Although this Hospital is located in Sriracha, many Club members use it because it often charges less than Bangkok Hospital Pattaya. Club members receive a 10% discount on medicines (inpatient and outpatient), main physical check up, and CT & MRI scans.
